





"Our group, along with Dr. Richard Smith, is proud to have donated land that expands the Flint Creek Savanna Preserve. It provides the opportunity for our practice to give back to the local community we serve," Greg Brebach, M.D., said. The land is now part of the Flint Creek Savanna Preserve, owned by Citizens for Conservation.

For more than four decades, Citizens for Conservation (CFC) has been instrumental in providing habitat for threatened species of plants and animals, such as the Sandhill Crane. CFC's educational outreach provides residents with programs about native plants, water conservation, pollinators, coyotes, deer, and other subjects of local interest. One of its signature projects is the preservation and restoration of Flint Creek Savanna—creating a large greenbelt preserve along Flint Creek from the CFC headquarters on Illinois Route 22 all the way to U.S. Route 14.

The donation is 4.0 acres with 3.4 acres straddling Flint Creek just east of the Lake Barrington Professional Office Condominium Association and south of Route 22, and an additional 0.6 as a conservation easement. The donation is of special value because it is home to some beautiful young oak trees that are in the prime of their reproduction. Many of the other oaks in the surrounding area are much older and are past the reproductive years.







HI! MY NAME IS JOEY YOUNG and I am a Life Scout in Barrington Troop 10 working on my Eagle Scout service project. My project beneficiary is Rainforest Connection. I chose this project because I believe in saving the rainforests for my generation and because most of the remaining rainforests are in Brazil, and I am half Brazilian.

Rainforest Connection is a nonprofit that repurposes old cell phones into listening devices and installs then high up in the trees of the world rainforests. When the device detects the sounds of chainsaws it sends a text message to the local authorities who respond in real time to apprehend the illegal loggers. I am collecting any type of used cellphones—working or not, any old types, or newer smartphones. Donors should wipe any stored personal data or remove SIM card prior to donating.
