Beer and Bread: Eating and Drinking in Ancient Babylonia

Would it surprise you to know that beer and bread were the staples of the Babylonian diet? Or that eating a locust was a delicacy? In fact, many of the modern pillars of Middle Eastern cuisine such as chicken, tomatoes, and peppers did not yet exist in Mesopotamia, so Babylonians combined these items with garlic, onions, and cucumbers. Assistant Professor for Assyriology Susanne Paulus will provide a fascinating peek into the diets and eating habits of this ancient culture, recipes included!

Austrian Economics Center Awards Richard J Stephenson Its Hayek Lifetime Achievement Award for 2019

STEPHENSON FAMILY FOUNDATION FOUNDER AND CHAIRMAN AWARDED PREEMINENT RESEARCH INSTITUTE'S HIGHEST HONOR IN RECOGNITION OF HIS LIFETIME OF SERVICE TO THE PRINCIPLES OF FREEDOM AND FREE ENTERPRISE

THE AUSTRIAN ECONOMICS CENTER (AEC) together with the Friedrich A. v. Hayek Institute (Hayek Institute) celebrated the 2019 recipients of the Hayek Lifetime Achievement Award, Mr. Richard J Stephenson and Mr. Tom E. Woods, Jr. at the 10th annual Hayek Lifetime Achievement Awards Gala, held on Thursday, November 14 at the Gartenpalais Liechtenstein. Over 300 guests gathered in honor of Mr. Stephenson and Mr. Woods.

H.S.H. Prince Michael of Liechtenstein presented Mr. Stephenson with the Hayek Lifetime Achievement Award in recognition of his significant entrepreneurial and philanthropic contributions to society. Mr. Woods' Lifetime Achievement Award was presented by Dr. Ingo Friedrich, who paid tribute to Woods' work as a noted libertarian scholar, author and media personality.

In his acceptance speech, Mr. Stephenson thanked AEC and the Hayek Institute for the


“undeserved but gratefully received and appreciated” award, explaining his deeply held belief that service to others isn't transactional, it is a way of life. “My parents taught me to live in accordance with a moral code: ‘When you see someone who is less well off than yourself, and you are in a unique position to do something about their plight, without harm to self, family or Lord, you simply step into the opportunity to relieve their burden, as best you can... No fuss, no muss, just go on about your business.’” Mr. Stephenson later added, “This is a joyful moment for me. It is a privilege to be honored tonight and to celebrate all the good work of which we are capable when we are free.”

“Mr. Stephenson has shown lifelong dedication to promoting entrepreneurial freedom and individual liberty as a leader, philanthropist, and entrepreneur. We are delighted to honor Mr. Stephenson and to recognize his success and service. He is a faithful proponent of the principles of the Austrian School and Friedrich A. v. Hayek, and we are grateful for his support in making sure these principles endure,” said Dr. Barbara Kolm, AEC founder and President of the Hayek Institute.

Highlighting Mr. Stephenson's contributions to the field of cancer treatment and care, both as the founder and chairman of Cancer Treatment Centers of America® (CTCA) and Gateway for Cancer Research, a nonprofit organization dedicated to funding early phase clinical trials,

Julian Hadschieff, Vice President of the Hayek Institute and CEO of PremiQaMed Group, a leading private health care provider in Austria, added: “Mr. Stephenson is a role model in both business and philanthropy. In 1988, he created one of the first private hospital networks built on the concept of providing truly individualized care. In 1991, he founded Gateway for Cancer Research, which has raised over \$85 million in support of transformational cancer research...Entrepreneurs and philanthropists like him are essential to the future of medicine.”

Terry Anker, a member of the board of The Friends of the Austrian Economics Center, closed the tribute to Mr. Stephenson noting that his “leadership of a remarkable revolution in health-care, attentive generosity, and inspirational spirit as an entrepreneur stands as a brilliant reminder of the immutable truth of free-market innovation and thoughtful compassion.”
