They look for socially and environmentally responsible manufacturers that follow strict rules of governance.

Kate McConville worked for the McHenry County Health Department and was also a consultant who taught breastfeeding skills and nutrition to low-income moms. Kate has two children of her own. Lori got into the children's toy business after trying to find quality toys for her own children. That, combined with a growing awareness of sustainability and environmental impact issues, moved her to research products.

She looked at toy safety issues, pushed for quality over quantity, and wanted toys that would not become landfill and a short window of use. "I believe that if you put people and the environment first, you will be successful," Lori said.

THOUGHTFUL CHARACTERISTICS

In addition to meeting exceptional safety standards and providing lots of play value, many of the team's toys and products have at least one of these characteristics:

- Responsible—Kindness Counts: Crafted by organizations that value socially responsible labor and/or manufacturing practices. Also, those that participate in community involvement programs and/or donate to charitable organizations.
- Fair Trade: Products that abide by Fair Trade guidelines for equal opportunity manufacturing and trade.
- Organic: Crafted with certified organic materials (up to 100%).
- Natural: Crafted with natural materials.
- Recycled: Crafted with sustainably harvested, recycled, and/or reused materials and/or packaging.
- Parent Crafted: Products crafted and founded by parents and familyowned companies.
- Active Play: Designed and ready for active, up and moving play indoors and outdoors.

Marvin's Toy Stores are located in Woodstock (inside Read Between the Lynes, a local bookstore on the Square), Crystal Lake (Williams Street), and now Barrington. Children playing with toys from Marvin's Toy Store won't know all the thought and care that went into their sourcing. But moms, dads, and others can rest assured that Marvin's Toys will last, sometimes for more than one generation, and bring imagination, wonderment, and the ability to foster their loved one's growth and learning.
