The question is where do you place it depending on your coloring. If spicy warm colors are not your thing, opt for teals, purples, or burgundies.

BLUE

Blue represents the desire for tranquility, strength, and optimism. The possibilities are endless.

EARTH TONES

Neutral doesn't have to be basic and boring. Pop it with color. Red tones add warmth and confidence, while pinkish purples suggest a touch of exotic.

ACCESSORIES

NECKERCHIEFS
