Wreaths Across America Day

A COMMUNITY SUCCESS AT EVERGREEN CEMETERY

THIS YEAR'S THEME for Wreaths Across America was "Serve and Succeed." This fifth annual patriotic remembrance event in Barrington was a success, primarily due to the support of the community organizations that made commitments of time and financial assistance.

Despite the rainy, chilly weather, nearly 200 people attended the Wreaths Across America Day program on Saturday, December 16 at Evergreen Cemetery in Barrington. Members of the Signal Hill Chapter of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution welcomed and guided community attendees to participate in a brief memorial service at noon, and then issued live balsam wreaths for placement on the graves of 807 Veterans interred at the cemetery.

Throughout 2023, the Signal Hill Chapter garnered financial support from Veterans of Lake Barrington Shores, American Legion Post 690, UBS Financial of Barrington, as well as Chapter members and area citizens.

Barrington High School's football team assisted with receiving and staging the delivery of multiple boxes of wreaths that had been received a few days prior. Barrington-area Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts participated in the Memorial Ceremony and honored guests included Village President Karen Darch and State Senator Dan McConchie.



Despite the weather challenges, all wreaths were placed in a 90-minute time frame.
